World Superbike—Phillip Island

Leon Haslam was one of the stars of the opening round of the 2011 Superbike World Championship season last weekend at Phillip Island. Last year's runner-up had looked to be struggling earlier in the week during the testing sessions, but when the flag dropped, the BMW Motorrad man was able to get and stay amongst the frontrunners, taking his S 1000RR to a brilliant third place in race 1.

"As a team we have made huge steps forward from two weeks ago. We still have some issues that need looking at in more detail to ensure we can become regular podium finishers, but on the whole we should be happy with the two races," he declared. "The first race was great; we encountered some issues in race two but still managed to finish in the top five, so we are definitely happy."

Despite the problems in race 2 the 'Pocket Rocket' was able to score more points with a fifth place, taking his total to a creditable 27 for the Australian weekend. The Derby man can now look forward with confidence to the next round at Donington, his home track, where he will surely be one of the protagonists.

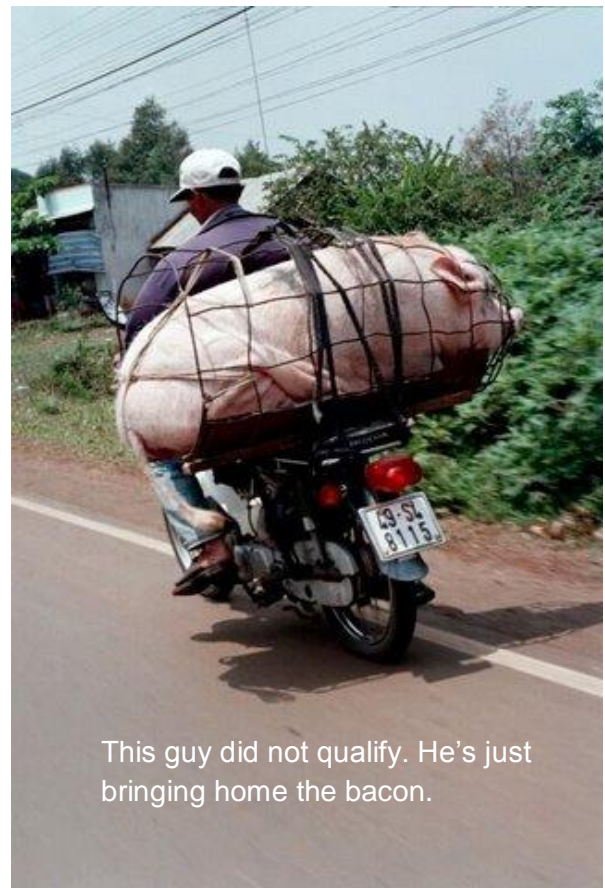


"A huge credit goes to the team for their efforts this weekend, but we now have to sit down and work out in detail how we plan to make that next step forward," he added.

Spain's Carlos Checa (Ducati Althea Racing) scored a splendid double win at Phillip Island, a repeat of his double win at Imola last September.

Just like in the first race, no one was able to run with the Spanish rider and he finished a couple of seconds ahead of Max Biaggi (Aprilia Alitalia).

2011 Riding Contest — Alphabet Towns ... Revised

This year we bring back the ABC towns contest that was last done in the mid 90's I believe. The concept is simple. Take a picture of your bike or self or both in front of the town sign or post office or firehouse that has the name of the town. Choose 26 cities, towns, villages that start with A through Z. The further away from home, the more points. Add up the miles and that's your total town miles.

I found a cool site that calculates miles in a straight line that can help assign points for your towns visited.

As an example, here I am in Antwerp, OH in 2008 for the International Cities Contest. I am 138 miles from home as the crow flies. I will have 138 miles to add to my total miles. The further you are away from home the better. I plan on using a spreadsheet to track my progress. Hint. ;-)

Contest begins as soon as the snow clears and ends in November.
